ITINERANT RETAIL MERCHANT: This merchant is a door to door sales person soliciting, selling or taking orders that does not have a fixed business location in Canadian.

- 1. Fill out form completely.
- 2. A current copy of applicant's driver's license.
- 3. Two recent photographs clear, not to exceed 1" square.
- 4. Must have a \$10,000. bond made payable to City of Canadian for solicitor or vendor.
- 5. Must have State Sales Tax permit number.
- 6. **\$25.00** fee for 30 day permit. May re-apply in 30 days. The permit is 1 per person who is going door to door. Each person fills out the form and each person provides pictures and \$25.00 fee.
- 7. A dated certificate or letter from the president, vice president, general manager, sales manager, assistant sales manager, or district or area manager of the company for which the applicant works, sells, or solicits, stating that the applicant is currently an employee or agent of such company.
- 8. Provide a reference to a recognized rating publication, which shall show the page on which the company's or firm's financial standing can be found; or a letter or a certificate from an association or organization which has as its purpose the protection of citizens of the United States against illegal or unsavory business practices stating that the firm or company is a member in good standing of such association or organization.
- 9. A background check will be performed. A permit **cannot** be issued if applicant has been convicted of a felony or a misdemeanor involving moral turpitude.
- 10. Obtain approval of the Director of Code Enforcement.
- 11. <u>Trespass by Permit Holder</u>: An itinerant merchant who has obtained a permit as required by Chapter 113 of the City of Canadian Code of Ordinances and who offers or attempts to sell goods or services to a homeowner or resident of an apartment through direct physical contact, including door to door solicitation, shall not approach or solicit a home or other residence during any times where a placard is displayed indicating that the homeowner or residential occupant does not wish to be solicited. Violation of this section will result in legal action according to Section 10.99 of the Code of Ordinances and revocation of the permit.

The applicant applying for a permit required by Ordinance 589, shall make and file with the Code Enforcement Officer a bond in the sum of \$10,000 executed by the applicant and two or more good and sufficient sureties, or by a solvent company authorized to do business in the state, to be approved by the Code Enforcement Officer, payable to the City of Canadian for the use and benefit of all persons as their interests may appear, who shall have cause of action against applicant by reason of misrepresentation of merchandise, misconduct, or fraud, or otherwise, which bond shall provide for the prompt payment of all just claims against the applicant and all judgments against such applicant, and all damages caused by the applicant. The bond shall further provide that the vendor shall comply with and observe all ordinances of the city and shall further provide that any persons who shall have any claim or cause of action against the applicant may sue the applicant and the sureties on the bond jointly or may sue the applicant without joining the sureties or may sue the sureties without joining the vendor.

FEE: The fee for a permit issued pursuant to Ordinance 589 shall be \$25.00

Signature of Applicant:

<u>PERMIT:</u> It shall be unlawful for any itinerant merchant or vendor to engage in any activity of which a permit is required, unless he or she carries such permit on his or her person while engaged in such activity. Any person receiving a permit issued under this sub-chapter shall display such permit upon request.

<u>**DURATION**</u>: All licenses or permits issued under Ordinance 589 shall be valid from the date shown thereon for a period of one month (30 days) unless sooner revoked as provided for in Ordinance 589.
